Alpine Skiing/Snowboarding


Some of the best downhill ski and snowboard action in the Midwest can be found in the Superior area!

Home to 11 runs, 320 feet of vertical drop, and unlimited fun. From beginners to professionals, Mont du Lac has it all and is conveniently located in Superior. <u>GPS</u>

• Spirit Mountain

Right across the St. Louis River is Spirit Mountain in Duluth, Minnesota. A bit larger than Mont du Lac, Spirit has 22 alpine runs xand over 700 feet of vertical drop. <u>GPS</u>



Fat-Tire Biking

Fat-tire biking has become increasingly popular over the last few years, and you won't have to go far to find opportunities in Superior and Douglas County!

- <u>Wild Rivers State Trail | Map</u> This is a snowmobile and ATV trail, but cycling is allowed! While it won't be groomed as a traditional bike trail, riders can still enjoy the packed-down snow from the snowmobiles.

Ice Fishing

Or head out on the St. Louis River where some lunkers are lurking:
